We also have concerns about the parking especially in Riddy Lane (see photo). Another concern is the continued speeding around Barnfield Avenue and Riddy Lane. This is despite the introduction of a 20 mile an hour limit on some of the roads in the Icknield area.

A complete review of traffic management needs to be undertaken for the whole of North Luton including the Icknield Ward. At recent area board meetings this matter has been raised many times. We must treat this as a high priority.

Another major problem which is always causing concern is litter from the fast food outlets. The council must deal with this as an urgent matter.

and that means he flip flops about and jumps on any bandwagon going.


