





### You are paying more council tax than you need to—for political reasons

In Luton South the Conservative Chancellor George Osborne has cut income tax for an estimated 44,948 people and taken 4,928 Luton South people out of tax altogether, saving a typical family around £700 per year.

Labour-run Luton Council has INCREASED council tax by 6.9% since 2011/12. The Conservative-led Coalition offered money to local councils to help them freeze their council tax but Luton preferred to raise council tax. In many other areas where the subsidy was taken up, council tax has fallen by an average of 11% in real terms since 2010. Who do you trust? Who is on your side?

Instead Luton Borough Council has closed your local libraries and laid off 100s of staff whilst pleading poverty. **If elected, we will NOT play politics with people's jobs.**
